WARRANTY TERMS

Auto Recyclers of Kansas 90 day standard warranty is limited to the following terms:

- 1. **Keep your receipt!** This is proof of purchase as well as showing the type of warranty purchased with the part. We cannot honor our warranty if you do not have your receipt.
- 2. Warranties are not transferable! Only the individual or business that purchased the part may make the warranty claim.
- 3. Warranties are for like parts only. Under no circumstances will a refund be given for a defective part if a like part can be provided by ARK.
- 4. If a customer purchases a replacement part before ARK has the opportunity to make good on the warranty, the warranty will be considered void and customer forfeits their claim to a refund.

The Mechanical Parts Warranty does NOT cover:

Breakdowns caused by non-covered components, improper installation, defective workmanship, usage for which the part was not intended and/or improper maintenance (e.g. using the incorrect types and levels of fluids and lubricants as outlined in the owner's manual).

All Warranties are Null and Void if:

- The vehicle is converted from private passenger use to commercial or fleet use, or is used for racing or other competition or off-road recreational purposes.
- Failure is caused by abuse, misuse, or modifications. Failure is caused by towing a trailer or other vehicle, unless the vehicle is equipped for this purpose as recommended by the manufacturer.
- The vehicle has been modified to plow snow, whether the snowplow is attached to the vehicle or not.
- The part fails or becomes defective due to the vehicle being involved in a collision.
 - Product is installed and operated outside the United States.
- The installed heat tab center is melted or has been removed.
 - The part is sold "AS IS" as indicated on the front of this invoice.

- We reserve the right to inspect any product prior to replacement.
- The year and model of the vehicle or part printed on this invoice is within a range of the interchangeability and may not necessarily be the exact model and year as the part or vehicle that has been provided.
- Refer to the Manufacturers "Owner's Manual" of your vehicle for the correct operation and maintenance schedule.
- This part may have accessories that are attached and must be switched or removed to accommodate proper installation, which is the responsibility of the installer. Such parts have been included to aid in the convenience of installation and are not covered by this warranty.
- Freight is not refundable for any reason.
- Reprogramming or relearning procedures are part of OEM repair processes; this must be considered before a part is considered defective. Costs to reprogram
 or relearn are the responsibility of the customer.

Lahor and Installation

- We are not responsible for injury or damages during, or as a result of, the installation of our product.
- Timing belts, thermostats, spark plugs, fluids and seals are routine maintenance items and should be replaced at the time of installation and at the manufacturers recommended service intervals.
- Proper operation of the cooling and electrical system must be checked during the installation of products that can be affected by those systems. While most fluids have been drained from our products, it is your responsibility to completely drain and replace fluids, lubricants, antifreeze, and filters that are fresh lean and approved by the OE manufacturer.
- Transmissions are guaranteed to be in good working order. Warranty covers slippage, shifting failures and/or bearing noise. Shearing or breaking of teeth in a standard transmission is not warranted under any circumstance. Improper installation will void all warranties. Customer must provide proof of service to validate claim. ARK does not cover any external leaks on transmissions. It is the responsibility of the installer to replace the radiator or transmission oil cooler, flush the transmission oil cooling lines, fill differential, adjust shifter mechanisms, replace filters, replace seals, replace pan gaskets and reset or replace computer codes when installing a transmission.
- Engines are guaranteed against engine knock, excessive smoke and oil consumption (>2 quart per thousand miles), inadequate oil pressure, turned bearings and cracks in head, block or pistons. Oil/fluid leaks. Loose timing belt/chains and fuel components, tune-ups, water pumps, distributors and exhaust manifolds, are not covered by this warranty. Warranty is contingent upon oil and filter change at installation and every 3,000 miles thereafter. Customer must provide proof of service to validate claim. Overheating and/or improper installation will void all warranties. NOTE: Excluded from this warranty are the fuel components, water pump, gaskets, all electrical parts, hoses, lines, intake and exhaust manifolds, fuel injector pump, all other fuel injection parts and all other external parts. Calibration and adjustment of excluded parts is also excluded from this warranty.
- **Rear Axle Assemblies** are guaranteed not to be noisy or have excessive axle wear. Brake systems are not covered by this warranty. Replacement of lubricating fluid is highly recommended.
- Claims related to the overheating and/or improper lubrication of the engine or its components are not covered by this warranty.

All implied warranties, including warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, are limited to the duration of this warranty and do not cover incidental or consequential damages. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts or the exclusion of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state.
